At the end of January, Pastors (now and future) of La Senda Antigua gathered for intensive seminary classes offered through our partners at CODEX Ministries. The course of study is offered over a 4 year period. 30 of our pastors are currently enrolled in the program.





In February, La Senda hosted pastors from the Buenas Nuevas Association from across the island. They gathered for training, worship, prayer and fasting, and much needed mutual encouragement.





During the Winter of 2020, mission team members (former, current, and future) from Lakewood Baptist Church of Jamestown, NY made donations to and worked in a snack bar for Upward basketball to raise funds to support the ministry, eventually collecting around \$2000. Team members took advantage of the opportunity to share photos of the work to facilitate excellent discussions about the work of the Lord through Ancient Path/La Senda in Cuba.

Caring for the Whole Person-2.0

A cornerstone of our ministry is representing the body of Christ in the care and healing of the whole person: body, soul, and spirit. Responding to COVID-19 in Cuba

No matter the situation, the work of the people of God never ceases. The worldwide health crisis is a call to the people of La Senda Antigua/The Ancient Path to find new ways to express the love of God and welcome people into the Kingdom.

March 19. As always, the work begins on our knees. One last gathering of the people in prayer and then a new mission commences, albeit with more personal space.



The work this last week has been to distribute what we have obtained to each of our mission Pastors across the whole region, that they in turn can provide for the people whom they serve, with priority on caring for the elderly and most needy, along with neighbors who don't typically have the benefit the love of a Christian community around them. Extending the reach of grace.





Monday, March 23 Pastor Jose reported that the stores were empty. What we see now in the US is but an echo of daily life in Cuba. In this time of crisis, there is nothing on their shelves. But, there is always a way. By that evening, a team from the church had found a resource some much needed essentials.



Pastor Jose describes encounters with non-believing neighbors- "I gave them a package of soup & seasoning, a small bag of potatoes, and a bar of soap. If you could have seen the faces, how astounded they were to receive it. Many people asked what they owed. I got to tell them it wouldn't cost them a penny. It is a gift from the Church."

Responding to COVID-19 in Cuba & USA

Don't stand so close to me is a rallying cry in the US. This photo is the reality of social distancing this week in line for necessities in Jovellanos. Not all peoples have the luxury of assuming we can keep six feet between us and still keep our spot in line. In a place where getting what you need means being sure you get to it before it runs out, you stay in line no matter how close up you have to be.

The work of the Kingdom of God continues even as routines are shaken. Here is a preview what we hope to do in 2020.

HOUSES. A very nice house (below) is for sale in the town of Perico in a great location and ready for use. \$22,500 enables a full-time Pastor to live and serve there. The house (right) in Sofia needs \$5-7.000 in renovations for the Pastors to live in it.





Two missions (Jaguey Grande & Matanzas) are actively searching for permanent homes to purchase and two other locations are in prayer over when to take that step forward. Your prayers and support are invaluable in these efforts.

CONSTRUCTION. Phase One at La Senda is nearly complete. Phase Two moves to the renovation of our worship area and the attached house. Once complete, our seating capacity will be enlarged by a third and class and activity space will double.

The current plan calls for our current worship shelter to be removed in its entirety to the mission at Sofia, where it will be recycled to serve as worship space in a new location.





The financial projection of Phase Two and relocation of the worship shelter to Sofia is currently being considered. We will keep you informed as the picture becomes clearer.

MISION MISERICORDIA, our relief ministry to the poorest regions of Cuba, starts its 5th season in 2020

It started with hurricane relief after Matthew in 2016. Since then, Ancient Path/La Senda Antigua has delivered food, clothing, wheelchairs, essential household appliances, and much more to aid a growing network of pastors serving in the mountainous jungle regions of eastern Cuba.

In 2020, we aim to bring mules, refrigerators, bicycles, and other necessities during a two-week trek from Jovellanos to Baracoa. Between \$12-15,000 will be need to cover the total cost of this mission effort.
