2023. An Extraordinary Year. In an Extraordinary Place. With Extraordinary People. Serving an Awesome God.

...we also glory in our suffering, for we know that suffering produces perseverance, perseverance character, and character hope. And hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.- Romans 5:3-5

In west central Cuba, we work in a region that has suffered. The province in which we are based is called Matanzas, which translates in English to "slaughters," being named after an ambush and subsequent massacre that happened here in 1510.

Loss and endurance, perseverance and overcoming are so indelible in the living of these days that, most often, a brother or sister in Christ here does not have much (if any) time to stop and think whilst working through it all as the hours tick by.

On one of our trips this year, a dear American friend inquired of Yami, "What do Cubans do in their spare time?"

To our experience this seems a very fair and logical question. Yami's response was concise and a pointed reminder of how differently Cubans have to measure their lives. To paraphrase, she told our group of Ohioans that "spare" or "free" time wasn't really a thing in Cuba. Cubans pretty much spend their waking hours (when not in some more traditional mode of work) resolving something. That is to say that they are figuring out how to work through/over/under/around some issue or obstacle.

There is, sewn into the fabric of their existence, a necessity to overcome something. It may be practical, physical, emotional, spiritual, or a combination of one or more of these, but daily, hourly, and always, there is a challenge to be met. This is where energies are spent. Even when it might seem that some have what we would call "time on their hands," spare time here doesn't quite relate to our concept.

Maybe this is why they are so adept as Kingdom builders.





Tonni & I have been blessed now with 17 years as members of the Santiago/Jobe family. 17 years of learning and loving Cuba. 17 years of being drawn by the Holy Spirit to invest more deeply in the advancement of the Gospel here. I am ever astounded at the new discoveries that await me every time I draw close and pay attention.

Yami and I have talked at length these last couple of months of the truly severe cost of working for the Lord. Amongst the mind bending discoveries made is understanding that when you make the decision to embrace discipleship, and march forward in your calling, the commitment comes at great price.

At the La Senda Antigua 12th birthday celebration in January 2023, Pastora Yami called for a year of advancement and acceleration, and we were off and running, measurably faster than we had before. Our goals were lofty and our challenges were many. The ties that binds us would be tested in ways few of us foresaw.



2023 for me personally was to be a year of discovering a little bit more about the perseverance and resolute spirit in which my Cubano family is steeped. There was more travel, more work, more issues to resolve, higher cost.

At times, it seemed to be a year spent chasing carrots held out in front of us; promises of many great places, experiences, and rewards to come. In the end, for a variety of reasons and circumstances, nearly all of those treats were lost,

at least for now. Reflecting this past week, a lyric from poet Rich Mullins seems to have summed up the cost of Kingdom service in 2023.

Everything that could be shaken was shaken and all that remains is all I ever really had.



For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. - 2 Corinthians 4:17-18

When Jesus approaches you and says, "Follow me," you gotta go. It's going to cost you. Your life will be shaken and you will find out "all you ever really had." You discover (if you are like me, repeatedly) that working for God's Kingdom is worth far more than it could ever cost. You discover that (like my Cubano brothers and sisters) the daily troubles and overcoming cannot compare to what happens if, by the grace of God, you can stay committed to the call.

After wrestling to resolve every issue, faithful disciples in Cuba often find ourselves paradoxically in the valleys full of shadows and at the top of the mountain all at once, glorying in suffering and success as the Holy Spirit manifests God's power in the manner of our fondest dreams. Advancement and acceleration. 2023 was full. Here is a glimpse of what your faithful partnership and record yearly giving has enabled.

New pastors/missionaries trained and more than half a dozen new house churches established in the region.








New building purchased and renovated for our expanding Children's Ministry
